## **July is Smart Irrigation Month**

While we love the look of our home landscapes, many include grasses and plantings that would struggle mightily if left to the mercy of our summers here in the arid West. Home irrigation systems deliver the water our yards need, but it's up to each of us to keep them running smartly.

- ♦ The Eye Test—Run a test cycle during a morning or evening on a scheduled watering day. Look at each sprinkler head to make sure it's working properly. If heads are failing to pop up, are tilted, or have gaps in their spray pattern, they need to be repaired or replaced. ECCV customers can receive rebates for a number of sprinkler components. Head to www.ECCV.org/rebates for more information.
- Slow the Flow—Get no-obligation, professional insight from a water efficiency pro. Our partners at Resource Central are scheduling these free system assessments throughout the summer. Book a consultation, and a specialist will come take a look at your landscaping, sprinkler system, and soil and let you know of any adjustments—many of which are do-it-yourself—that could help save water while still producing great results for your yard. See the info on the right for how to apply.
- Cycle & Soak—Summer heat can bake our clay-based soil, making it even harder for water to soak into it. Watering each zone of your yard in three cycles (see recommended cycle durations above) with about one-hour between each cycle gives soil the time to soften and absorb more water.
